DST/AIDS PM decided to first implement in services further away from the city center and, in a pioneering way, also in Testing and Counseling Center. There was training of the teams and relocation of medical professionals to expand the supply.

In addition, communication materials were produced to disseminate PrEP.

Recommendations


- Expand PrEP's access to the most vulnerable populations and priority populations




